The Discworld Convention is a gathering of fans of Sir Terry Pratchett that happens in the UK once every two years.

This is an event organised by the fans themselves and any profit that is made is donated to our nominated charities.

From the Opening Ceremony on the Friday evening to the Dead Monkey Party on the Monday night there will be a series of talks, panels and hands-on activities. There will be games, theatre, music and entertainment, not to mention the Charity Auction where items of Discworld memorabilia can be bid for and the Dealers' Room where there are things to prise even the tightest wallet open.

The (not so) small print

Membership is your ticket to the Convention. Full membership includes attendance at all four days of the Convention plus subscription to all electronic or paper updates. Entry to all programme items is included (with the exception of the Gala Dinner which is a special extra-cost event), plus access to the Dealers' room and the opportunity to take advantage of our specially-negotiated rates for food, drink and accommodation.

Concessionary rates are available for students, pensioners, and benefit qualified individuals (proof will be required at the event). Ages 13 to 17 years (inclusive) are charged at the concessionary rate. There is no charge for children ages 12 and under, but we must receive an application for them. Any minor **MUST** be accompanied by an adult member (full or concessionary) who accepts full legal responsibility for the minor for the duration of their stay at the Convention.

Supporting membership includes subscription to all electronic or paper updates prior to the event, but not attendance at the event. Supporting membership may be converted to full membership at any time at the applicable rate (full or concessionary) on the initial date of purchase. Think of it as a means of reserving a place if you are not sure if you will be able to attend.

Physical tickets are not issued, you will receive a membership pack with all the relevant information when you arrive at the Convention and go to the registration area (clearly signposted). Membership fees are non-refundable. If you are unable to attend you may sell or give your Membership to another person. It is very important to inform us if you do this, so that we can record the transfer.

Transfer of Memberships, as well as any changes to Membership details, can only be done up to 21 days prior to the start date of the convention. All costs quoted are per person in pounds Sterling. Membership charges are those valid on the date of application. Cheques must be drawn on a UK bank in pounds Sterling. We regret we are unable to accept American Express or Diners Club cards.
